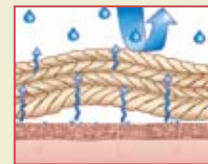
Beginning in 2006, Ruskovilla transitioned to the use of certified organic wool across their product line for the health of the world as well as your family.

Why wool?

It maintains the body's optimal temperature in cold and hot environments, while feeling good on the skin. It breathes, so it keeps you warm, but doesn't make you sweat. Especially important for children, wool is fire resistant, unlike synthetics that require only a spark to ignite.

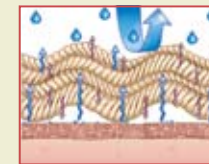

Wool breathes



naturally wicking water away from the skin.

Wool becomes curly when wet



leaving more air between the skin and the knitted fabric, so you stay warm.

super fine Merino wool

Super fine Merino wool fibers are seven times finer than those of normal wool, so it is soft + elastic.
